



EL PASO

Grown from a series of community-initiated partnerships, the College of Architecture program offered at Texas Tech University Higher Education Teaching Site at El Paso (TTU at El Paso) is part of a joint program with El Paso Community College. Local aspiring architecture students can take their first two years of courses with the community college, and finish their Bachelor of Science in Architecture at TTU at El Paso without leaving home.



FREDERICKSBURG

In partnership with Central Texas College, Texas Tech University Higher Education Teaching Site at Fredericksburg is part of the Hill Country University Center. Many bachelor degrees and teacher certification are offered. And with state-of-the-art facilities, wine labs and a teaching vineyard, students can have hands-on learning experiences to prepare for a career in the winemaking industry.



HIGHLAND LAKES (MARBLE FALLS)

Also in partnership with Central Texas College, Texas Tech University Higher Education Teaching Site at Highland Lakes is part of the Frank Fickett Educational Center in Marble Falls. The innovative TechTeach program was designed to meet the needs of Hill Country region students wishing to pursue their teacher certification. Students can complete their certifications or one of many bachelor degrees in the classroom or online.



JUNCTION

Home of the Llano River Field Station and the Outdoor School, Texas Tech University Center at Junction captivates visitors young and old with its nature trails and wildlife. It's complete with classrooms, meeting facilities, laboratories, lodging, dining hall, and outdoor amphitheater. It provides academic, research, and service programs to expand educational, economic, and cultural opportunities throughout the Hill Country region.



COLLIN (McKINNEY)

Texas Tech University at Collin Higher Education Center (TTU at Collin) is the most recent addition to Texas Tech's line-up of regional sites. In partnership with Collin College in McKinney, TTU at Collin is offering bachelor degrees in Human Sciences, General Studies, and University Studies in the Dallas/Fort Worth metroplex beginning in Spring 2016, with additional programs to be added as the partnership grows.



WACO

Texas Tech University Higher Education Teaching Site at Waco (TTU at Waco) resides on the scenic campus of McLennan Community College and offers upper level courses toward a bachelor's degree. Students complete most of their core curriculum requirements with the community college, and the upper level requirements with TTU at Waco. Degrees offered include Biology, General Studies, University Studies, and the B.A.A.S.
