ART 4326/5326: PHOTOGRAPHY-ARTIST BOOKS

Students created three artist's books, using any materials they chose. Lectures covered photography, collage, Photoshop, and printing.

ART 4328/5328: PRINTMAKING

Students learned lithography, woodcut and intaglio processes, while also being encouraged to investigate personal imagery and mixed-media.

ART 4320/5320: EXPERIMENTAL DRAWING & PAINTING

Studio time focused on mixed media, while the written portion focused on themes to be presented at the upcoming Interdisciplinary Arts Conference.

ART 4390/5390: DOCUMENTARY FILMMAKING

This course examined basic theories, and techniques of video production in the field, and provided a basic understanding of aesthetics.
